This section is for treating people who wear complete dentures. About 50 million people in the United States are missing all of their teeth and most of them wear dentures. Most of them have to use messy adhesives to keep their dentures in place. This entire field of dental implantology was developed to help these people.

If a patient is missing all of their teeth in either jaw or both jaws, there are several options available for dental implant replacement. This section will explore those options with many patient presentations showing you the details of the work performed.
